Herewith are supplied the names and authors of many of the Hymns found in the beloved Hymnal known as the "Zion's Harp."

We are indebted to brethren and friends, who have assisted in supplying the names of authors and composers. Inasmuch as the authors and composers are not supplied with the hymns appearing in the Zion's Harp, there is a desire, and interest, among many brethren and friends to know the authors and historical background of the various Hymns.

Some date back to fifteenth and sixteenth centuries, during which time the believers suffered persecution, martyrdom, exile, and imprisonment. This moved believers to express their sorrow and trials and testings of faith in poetic verse to be passed on to others for encouragement in faith's conflicts.

Possibly to avoid persecution the names were intentionally withheld from the Hymnal as it now appears.

We are indebted to brethren and friends of this time for the melodies supplied to various hymns.

It will be observed that melodies were written by former noted composers, which places the Hymns in a class of fine music and harmony.
